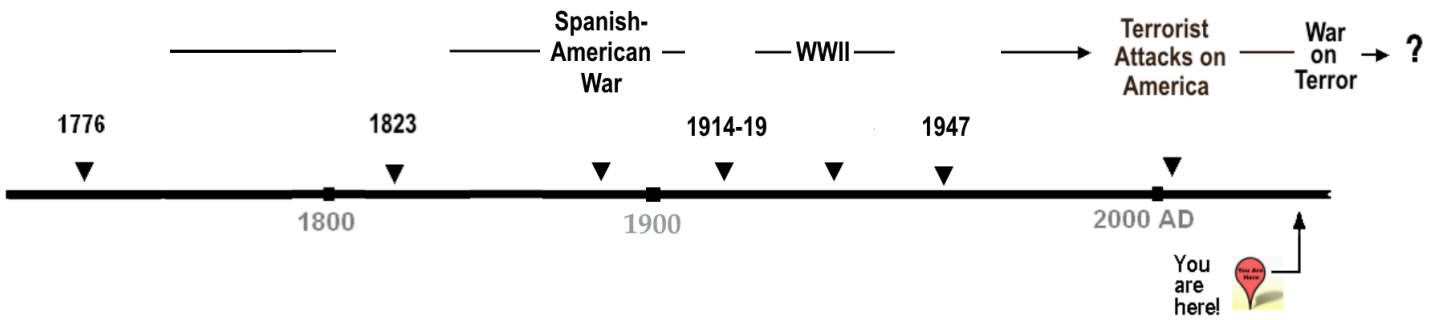
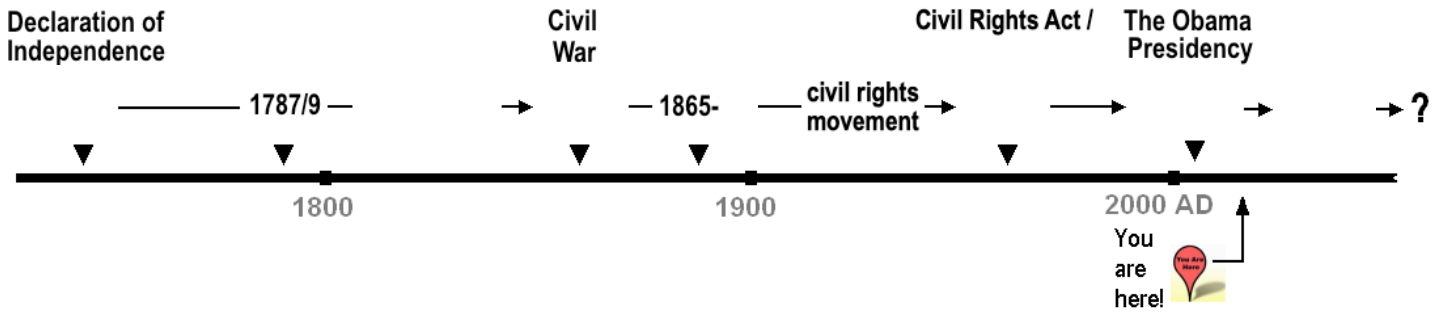


Part 1: Facts Practice
