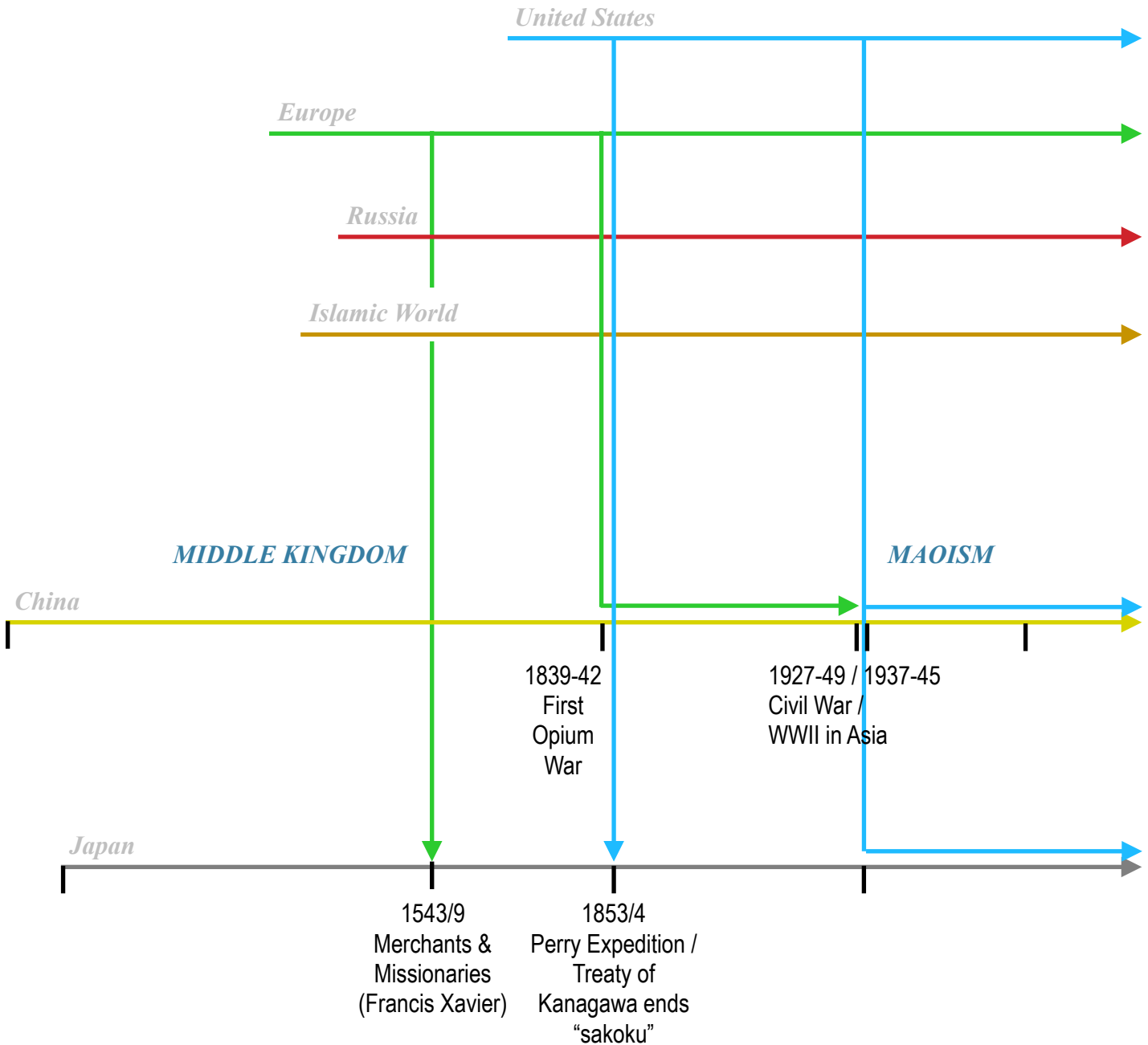


Part 1: Timeline of East Asia and the World We Live In
