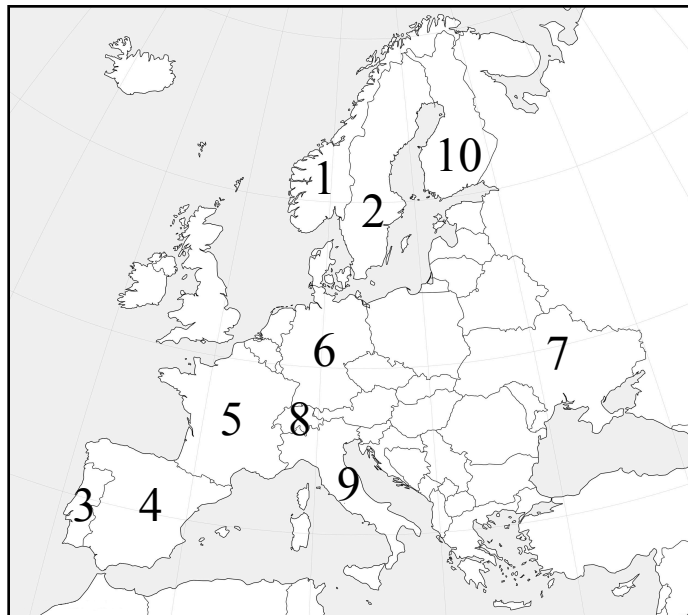


Part 1: The World We Live In 1.0

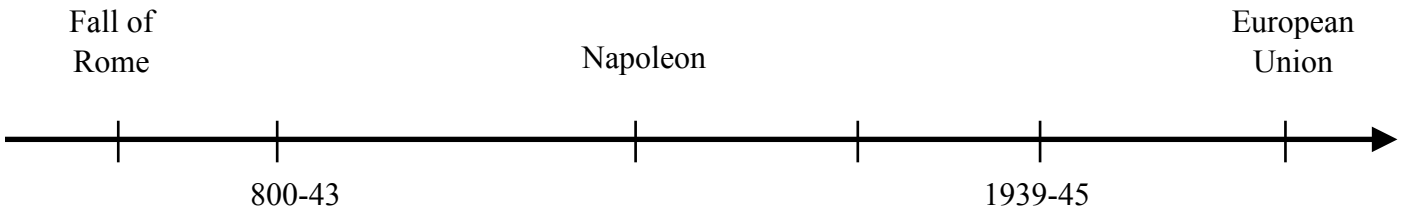


3. Write out a single sentence that captures the identity of the European Union today as a cultural block. Be sure to explain any special vocabulary that you have used.
