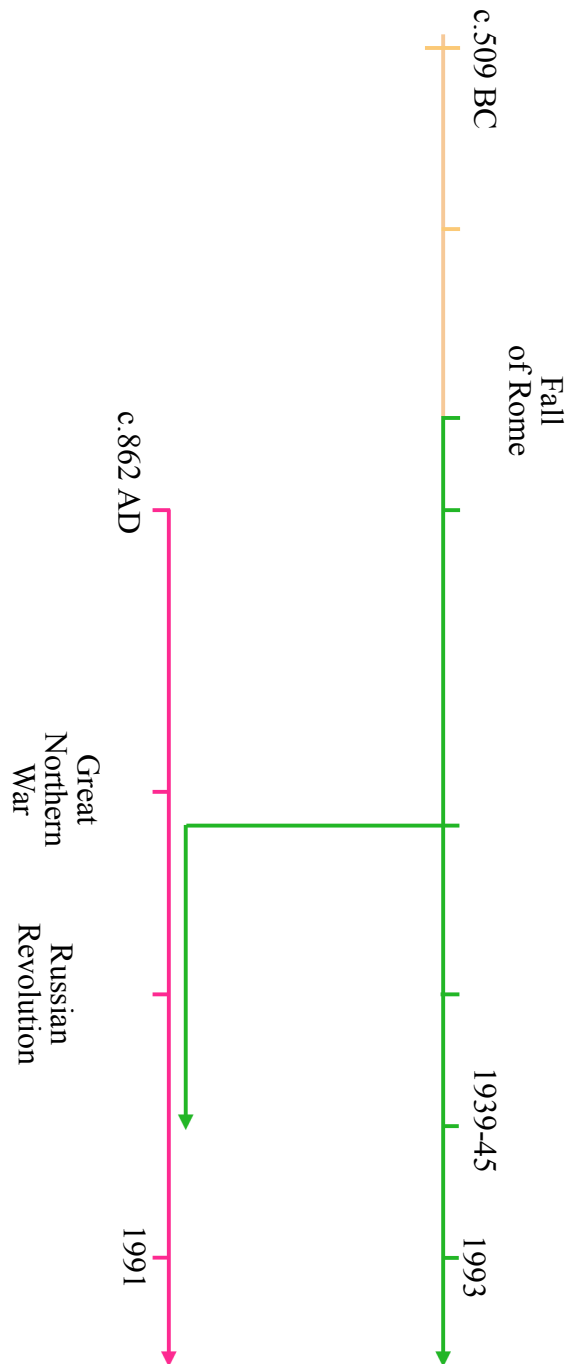


Part 1: Europe, Russia, and the World We Live In
