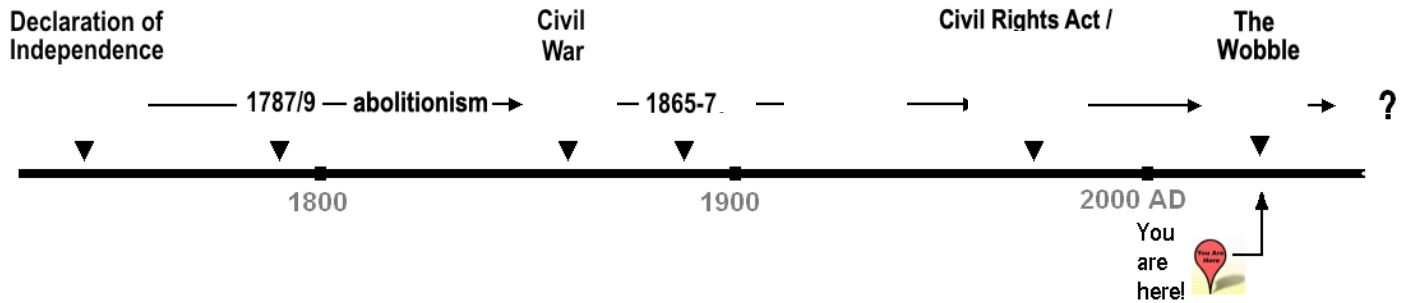


**Part 1: Facts Practice**
