American government today has grown from the small, individual rights-oriented government of the founding fathers to a massive, entangled blob of politicians and regulations.

- The original government was small, and had the purpose of protecting individual rights
- 1. The founding fathers set up protections against the government becoming too powerful
- However, over time it took upon itself the duty to intervene during social crises,
- 2. Seeds of government growth in the idea that internal improvements are necessary to remain independent
- 3. \circ Brief history of political economy and the crises which sparked the different phases (agrarianism \rightarrow mercantilism \rightarrow regulation)
- Leading to the government growing in both physical and economic power.
- 4. The American military is the most powerful in the world
- 5. The budget, debt, departments and their effect on the economy

The *American* Government today is powerful and dangerous (*to rights*).

- 1. The government used to be small and had a working system of checks and balances, therefore being less powerful.
- 2. The government started to become bigger over time, and therefore more powerful.
- 3. The government started becoming more corrupt and ergo inclined to grow, and then became more corrupted as it grew.
- 4. The government became more corrupted because of power and more powerful because of corruption.
- 5. The government became dangerous due to its power, especially as the world police.
- 6. The government became dangerous due to its corruption, especially as the world police.
- 7. The government became dangerous because it became bigger, gargantuan even.
